President's Message

CD4 and RAP are erecting a fence along Mulholland Hwy. at the illegal vista point. It was discussed that the type of fencing they are selecting will just become a bench for tourists. It is believed that CD4 will just put it up and hope for the best. Joe Salaices of RAP told several board members at a May meeting that no EIR was necessary to re-plant the vista and that it could happen at any time. It was decided to get a consensus from the adjoin neighbors most affected by the illegal site.

New Business

The 2012 HHA Operating Manual was discovered in documents dropped off for archiving.

LAPD has selected Annabelle Eubanks as the areas new SLO. Both she and Sargent Ben Thompson will be invited to the October meeting.

Zoning & Public Works

Chris has invested 60 hours replying to the Hollywood Community Plan. The “elephant in the room” – the Hollywood Sign is not addressed in the plan. Also, there is no discussion of a visitor center in the plan.

Beautification

While walking at the top of Deronda, Robert ran into former Councilman Tom LaBonge. LaBonge stated that CD4 does not have the guts to oppose the anti-Hollywoodland groups.

History/Archiving

The boxed archives housed in North Hollywood have been digitized. The minutes from 2002-2009 are still missing. It was suggested that we contact each board member for the years to see if they can be recovered.

HUNC

Nothing new affecting the neighborhood and the council has yet to take up the Hollywood Community Plan.

Party Houses
